Quality German Courses

The Humboldt-Institut has been teaching German for over 45 years. With more than 85,000 students from over 160 countries, the Humboldt-Institut is one of the most experienced language schools for teaching German in Germany.

We offer intensive German courses for all ages, all language levels and at any time of the year. All intensive courses are offered as packages including accommodation, full board, daily activities and excursions.

The Humboldt-Institut Course System

Weeks

The levels of our courses – A1, A2, B1, B2, C1 and C2 – are based on the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages. The **intensive courses** for all ages are divided in stages of five weeks each. At the end of each level, a level test has to be passed to move on to the next higher level.

For total beginners, the course start is possible at the beginning of an A1 level. Students with previous knowledge of German can join an already running course.

Thanks to a comprehensive **placement test**, we can place students according to their knowledge, ensuring small and homogeneous classes.

All students, from beginners to advanced learners, are taught at the level that suits them best and are efficiently guided on their way to the desired learning goal.

Teaching and Learning

Only German is spoken inside and outside the classroom. In our **total immersion concept**, students dive into the German language right from the beginning.

All basic skills such as listening, reading, speaking and writing are systematically trained in the classroom. In addition, great care is taken that students actively master the grammar. German + Boarding Schools in Germany

The "Secondary Education in Germany" program is geared towards highly motivated students and offers them the chance to attend a boarding school in Germany. There the students will study to pass the Abitur, which is the required diploma for university admission in Germany.

In order to be admitted to a German boarding school, international students must demonstrate above-average academic performance, as well as sufficient knowledge of German. In our

residential language schools, we offer our students ideal conditions to prepare themselves and get used to a life in Germany.

After having successfully completed the German course, students are transferred to one of over 40 partner boarding schools and are integrated into a class according to their age and performance level. The Humboldt-Institut cooperates with highly respected boarding schools throughout Germany and will gladly help students to find the right school for them.


German Courses for Adults
